3. You agree to read and familiarize yourself with the rules, particularly the "local" CDBL rules.

You agree to strive to do your best to be impartial and "call the game" you are working to the best of your ability, understanding that your involvement has an important impact on the enjoyment of the game for the players, coaches and parents. Assignments for the playoffs at the end of the season will be determined by merit and with the input of the coaches.
